The agencies are required to get the work done through experienced personnel with professional skills and resources to provide the services required by the RECPDCL in timely and efficient manner on the terms and conditions set herewith.

Considering large quantum of work to be completed in time bound manner, RECPDCL tends to bid separate proposal (4 package) for above mentioned work under the Jurisdiction of all 4 DISCOMs (PUVVNL, PVVNL, MVVNL, DVVNL) of UP detailed under Section IV & Annexure VIII. Note: Bidders may participate in all packages, subject to meeting the pre-qualification Criteria (Section VI) for particular package, but in no case, a single bidder shall be awarded more than two package, subject to meeting Eligibility criteria of both packages.

The financial bids of technically qualified bidder will be opened sequence wise i.e. Package 1 first, then Package 2 and so on, subject to meeting Eligibility criteria mentioned. If a bidder found successful for first two package, then the bid submitted by the bidder for remaining packages shall not be opened. The rest package(s), left shall be awarded in the same manner to the successful qualifying bidder from remaining bids.

However before quoting rates, it is suggested that interested bidders may assess the data and its various parameters etc. The network shall be modelled as per the geographic information

collected during GPS/GIS survey which shall be superimposed on Geo referenced Google earth maps.

The work under the project shall be covered mainly for rural areas and the detailed scope of work is as mentioned below:

- i. Field Survey will be conducted in left out un-electrified rural households which are not in the vicinity of 40 mtrs. from existing infrastructure/pole with an objective to connect left out un-electrified rural households.
- ii. Habitation/Village wise Single Line Diagram (SLD) would be prepared for proposed infrastructure for electrification of left out un-electrified rural households.
- iii. In the villages where infrastructure is already available only DTR capacity will be recorded along with number of electrified and un-electrified households of the villages for assessment of enhancement in capacity of existing DTRs & proposal for providing service connection.
- iv. Survey will be conducted for all Unconnected Rural House hold and location of the landmark for proposed infrastructure will be recorded. Single Line Diagram (SLD) would be prepared based on GPS Co-ordinated captured during survey with landmark location.
- v. Villages/ habitations which are left out in earlier schemes of DDUGJY – 10th, 11th& 12th plan & DDUGJY (New) shall also be covered in scope of survey.
- vi. Load growth for at least next 5 years.
- vii. The realistic load assessment after proper survey of all unconnected rural households will be assessed for better system reliability.
- viii. Details of the nearest existing Distribution Transformer/HT/LT line from where tapping need to be provided, will be recorded.
- ix. Carrying out GPS based survey of existing & proposed infrastructure i.e. Transformers, HT/LT lines, BPL/APL connections of the identified town, village, habitation and feeder etc.
- x. Noting down various parameters as specified by RECPDCL at each surveyed point (e.g. single pole, double pole, transformer, conductor details including hardware materials, number of service connections etc.) and entering them in database/ MS-Word/MS-Excel Format etc.
- xi. Plotting of the GPS points on the Map for the surveyed locality with proper legends & colouring schemes and proper landmark.
- xii. Creation of GPS based Single Line Diagram (SLD)/map for the surveyed area showing Transformers, HT/LT lines, BPL/APL connections as per requirements of RECPDCL. A sample format for GPS based SLD/ map is attached at Annex-E for reference only.
- xiii. Provision of export of surveyed points in various Formats like MS-Word/MS Excel sheet etc. as per requirement of RECPDCL.
- xiv. Digital Photography of Poles, Transformer, HT/LT Conductor, Service Connection, Electrical Equipments & its accessories installations and workmanships etc. at least in 1200 X 800 resolutions in JPEG, GIF formats etc. as per requirement.
- xv. Submission of duly verified Parameter Database/MS-Word/MS- Excel sheet as prescribed by RECPDCL along with SLD, Digital Photographs, GPS readings in hard & soft copies.
- xvi. Plotting of the GPS points on the Map for the surveyed locality with proper legends and

- colouring schemes and proper landmarks from the data collected from the site.
- xvii. Preparation of Single Line Diagram (SLD) in prescribed format with proper legends and colouring schemes.
 - xviii. Submission of final deliverables in hard & soft copies as per project standards as required by RECPDCL.
 - xix. Submission of final deliverables in soft copies as per project standards as required by RECPDCL. Input data/details shall be provided through E-mail/ RECPDCL portal and final deliverables to be submitted through E-mail/ RECPDCL portal.
 - xx. All assets information along with nomenclature in the drawing viz. Name, length, quantity etc. shall be provided by the bidder in Single Line Diagram.

1. DELIVERABLES

Submission of duly verified survey reports parameter Database/MS-Word/MS-Excel sheet in the formats as prescribed by RECPDCL along with SLD (to be verified by agency from the representative of Discom in case of such requirements), Digital Photographs of landmarks/major assets etc. All the data are to be uploaded on RECPDCL's portal (www.recpdcl.in). Portal will be made available to agency once they start the work. Softcopy of the SLD prepared by the agency are to be provided in pdf as well as GIS (SHP) format(s) with proper attributes or any other format(s) as feasible/requirement of RECPDCL.

2. Any changes or additional work as may be required by respective Discom as the case may be is to be carried out by agency without demur/protest/damage.

3. COORDINATION: Agency shall inform the name & address of the Nodal Officer who will report about their regular daily progress & performance of the assignment. Daily progress report as per the requirement of RECPDCL should be sent to **RECPDCL corporate office & Project Office** in prescribed Performa. In case, absence of any information is adversely affecting the progress of work, the issue could be escalated to **Addl. CEO, RECPDCL**.

B. Performance/Progress Evaluation

1. The Bidder is required to submit the Time Schedule/Plan of implementation of the assignment as a sample case for one district with details of manpower & equipment's deployment as per **Annexure-VI**. The Time Schedule/Plan should be prepared in such a way that work may start within 01 days from the date of issue of work order and inspection of network as per scope of work/requirement of RECPDCL in the allotted districts including submission of reports shall be submitted within **30** days. Agency may propose their milestone targets to complete the work before schedule.
2. The agency concerned shall also provide Name/Contact Nos./Email IDs/Fax No. of all Key management officials.
3. Completion of assignment in time is most important element of the contract. The progress of

work shall be evaluated on daily basis vis-à-vis proposed milestone target for completion of work. Submission of quality survey reports & SLD will be the criteria with which the progress of the work will be measured.

- 4. Sample checking of Survey Reports & SLD etc. may be done by RECPDCL team and if any deviation is found unreported or incorrectly reported by the agency concerned, then RECPDCL will ask the agency for re-submission either of the particular GPS survey reports & SLD etc. or complete data as decided by RECPDCL.**

SECTION-V
GENERAL CONDITIONS OF BID

1. The bidder should submit the documents through e tendering mode viz. **letter of submission of Tender Document enclosed as Form-I, General criteria details enclosed as form-II, Financial bid/Performa of schedule rates enclosed as form-III, Annexure-I, Letter of Transmittal enclosed as annexure-II**, for evaluation of their bids. Original of requisite EMD to be submitted in original on or before last date of submission of Bids, fulfilling the above conditions will only be evaluated by the duly constituted evaluation committee. Bids of the bidders not fulfilling the conditions given above may be summarily rejected. Undertaking for subsequent submission of any of the above documents will not be entertained under any circumstances.
2. The bids will be opened sequence wise i.e. Package 1 first, then Package 2 and so on, subject to meeting Eligibility criteria mentioned.
3. Bidders may participate in all packages, subject to meeting the Eligibility Criteria for particular package, but in no case, a single bidder shall be awarded more than two package, subject to meeting Eligibility criteria of both packages. If a bidder found successful for first two package, then the bid submitted by the bidder for remaining packages shall not be opened. 1. ASSIGNMENT AWARD METHODOLOGY

- a) The Financial bids of technically qualified bidders will be opened sequence wise i.e. Package 1 first, then Package 2 and so on and consideration of bidders will be taken accordingly.
- b) Bidders may participate in all packages, subject to meeting the Eligibility Criteria as per Section VI- Eligibility Criteria for particular package.
- c) Work shall be awarded to the respective lowest bidder of each package (each package shall be considered a different entity of work.). But in no case, a single bidder shall be awarded more than two package subject to meeting Eligibility criteria of both packages.
- d) If a bidder found successful for first two package, then the bid submitted by the bidder for remaining packages shall not be opened. The rest package(s), left shall be awarded in the same manner to the successful qualifying bidder from remaining bids.
- e) RECPDCL reserves the right to split /merge the packages at its sole discretion.
- f) If certain quantity remains unallocated, RECPDCL may re-distribute such quantity among the successful bidders (to whom quantity is already allocated) in orderly manner at its sole discretion.

2. Preparation of Financial Bids

- a) The Agency should upload Bid document with duly signed copy of the requisite documents through digital signature.
- b) The Bidders are required to submit the complete financial bid documents through e-tendering only after satisfying each and every condition laid down in the tender documents. Other forms the bid shall be summarily rejected.
- c) Do not upload Financial Bid document with any other bid documents. Financial bid has to be uploaded separately.
- d) All rates should be in figures and in words. In case of discrepancy between the words and the figures the rate indicated in words shall prevail.
- e) Rates quoted should be firm and fixed. No price variation and escalation will be allowed.

3. Submission of Financial Bid:

- b) In case of inadequacy or non-submission of EMD amount, the Bid shall be deemed to be disqualified and summarily rejected in the technical evaluation.
- c) The initial validity of EMD shall be for a period of 180 days from the last date of bid submission. The validity of EMD shall have to be suitably extended, if necessary, as per requirement of RECPDCL, without which the Financial Bid /work order shall be rejected.
- d) Request for adjustment of Earnest Money Deposit against any previous dues with RECPDCL will not be considered.
- e) EMD will be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders within 30 days after finalization of the tender without any interest.

14. DISPUTES RESOLUTION & ARBITRATION

1. Disputes under the agreement shall be settled by mutual discussion.
2. However, in the event amicable resolution or settlement is not reached between the parties, the differences of disputes shall be referred to and settled by the Sole Arbitrator to be appointed by Chairman, RECPDCL.
3. The arbitration proceedings shall be in accordance with the prevailing Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and Laws of India as amended or enacted from time to time.
4. The venue of the arbitration shall be New Delhi, India.
5. The fee & other charges of Arbitrator shall be shared equally between the parties.
6. The Arbitrator will give the speaking & reasoned award. The party will not be entitled to any pendent lite interest during arbitration proceedings.

15. JURISDICTIONS OF COURTS ETC.

The Courts/ any other Tribunal or Forum in Delhi/ New Delhi alone shall have exclusive jurisdiction with regard to any matter/dispute relating to or arising out this contract.

16. SUB-CONTRACTING

Agencies to which work is awarded are not allowed to Sub-contract the work to any other parties either in part or full.

17. LETTER OF TRANSMITTAL

Letter of transmittal as per enclosed format "**Annexure-I**" to be submitted along with EMD In a sealed envelope for each Package separately.

18. QUANTITY VARIATION/ SPLIT OF WORK

- a. RECPDCL reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity/ volume of work, split of the work to Agencies or other terms and conditions at the sole discretion of the RECPDCL. Suitable Amendment/communications shall be issued in the event of variations in the quantities/ volume.
- b. It will be imperative on each bidder to fully acquaint itself of all factors/ activities which would

have effect on the performance of the work and its cost.

- c. The bids will be opened sequence wise i.e. Package 1 first, then Package 2 and so on.
